Shariaty and Founders of Sociological Thought (The Investigation on the Relation between Shariaty's Thought and Pioneering Sociologists' Theories)

Abstract

The present article tries to investigate the effect of founders of sociological thoughts (Karl Marx, Max Weber & Emile Durkheim) on Ali Shariati's ideas.
